

## YOUR VOTE IS YOUR VOICE.

You may register to vote by scanning the below QR code with your phone, by visiting <u>ova.elections.il.gov</u>, or submitting a paper registration form to your election authority.



You must be a United States Citizen.

You must be 17 years old on or before the date of the Primary Election and turn 18 on or before the date of the General or Consolidated Election. You must live in your election precinct at least 30 days prior to Election Day. You may not claim the right to vote anywhere else.

You must have a valid driver's license or state ID to register online.
